Don't just set aside hours, some regional expeditions deserve overnighting. Get comfy out of town and explore slowly.

# TURRAKANA / TASMAN PENINSULA

Take a trip down the peninsula. Famed for Port Arthur Historic Site, one of the best preserved convict sites in Australia, there's much this region offers. Venture southeast from the city, passing through Sorell and across Dunalley's Denison Canal where you can grab salty fresh fish and chips. Don't miss the lookout at Eaglehawk Neck. nor the natural features forming the Tessellated Pavement and Devil's Kitchen. The Coal Mines Historic Site is also worth a peek on your way down.

The peninsula highway is a journey into the past. At Eaglehawk Neck, see where dogs were chained to warn guards of escaping convicts. Visit the Port Arthur prison further south where you can explore the grounds, harbour and buildings of the 19th century settlement.

Feel like walking the world's edge? The Three Capes Track has gained a reputation as one of Australia's great coastal walks. Take the four day trek along towering sea cliffs, passing Tasman Island on a 46-kilometre adventure. There's also kayaking and day walks like Crescent Bay, devils to meet at Taranna and the giant waves of infamous Shipstern Bluff. The Tasman Peninsula has only one request – to give it more than a day.

# NIPALUNA / GREATER HOBART AND SURROUNDS

nipaluna / Greater Hobart is a capital set between the sea and its mountain. It's a city of sandstone, sails and humming culture. A great way to meet Hobart is from its pinnacle, standing atop kunanyi/Mount Wellington. Down below are stories untold, from Tasmanian Aborigines to wayward explorers, convicts to brewers, and colourful characters who have shaped our city.

The historic warehouses of Salamanca Place now house artist studios, galleries and modern eateries; a fitting backdrop for bustling Salamanca Market each Saturday. Nearby, pick up the Southern Ocean's latest catch at a bobbing fish punt or dine waterside in a floating restaurant. Upriver, the Museum of Old and New Art (Mona) invites exploration of David Walsh's subversive wonderland.

Explore Hobart's North, including the Corridor of Modern Art and Moonah Arts Centre, before grabbing a bite in multicultural Moonah.

Across the River Derwent, beachside Bellerive is home to Blundstone Arena, where AFL clashes and international cricket matches play out. The call of southern beach swells mean South Arm is popular among surfers and further inland, the village of Richmond remains a constant favourite. Wander the Georgian streetscape, cross Australia's oldest bridge and meet cool-climate vineyard neighbours of the Coal River Valley.

# HERITAGE HIGHWAY, CENTRAL HIGHLANDS AND DERWENT VALLEY

The Heritage Highway's country villages and gentle rural landscapes invite a slower pace. In Pontville, Kempton and Oatlands, the steps of sandstone cottages are worn through years of welcomes. These towns hold stories of bushrangers, convict road-gangs and pioneer settlers who ventured into Tasmania's midlands.

Those with a penchant for antiques should follow the River Derwent banks upstream from Hobart to New Norfolk. Continue on through hop fields to find yourself at Mount Field National Park where Russell Falls thunders from multiple tiers. Let gravity have its way at the Maydena Bike Park. Towering forests, salmon ponds, rugged mountains, the mighty Gordon Dam and Lake Pedder can also be found in these parts.

Head to Bothwell, one of Australia's earliest inland settlements for a round of golf on Australia's oldest course, followed by a dram by the open fire. The highland lakes and rivers teem with trout, attracting international anglers. Try your luck at Penstock Lagoon, the Great Lake at Miena, Little Pine, Bronte Lagoon and Bradys Lake, Further on is Lake King William and Lake St Clair, Australia's deepest lake and the completion point of the famed Overland Track. Lace up your boots for some great short walks and vivid wildflowers up this way. Wander the tiny township of Hamilton on the banks of the Clyde River.
