

CLARENCE CITY COUNCIL ACCESSIBLE TOURING OPTIONS



Each property has been individual inspected for accessibility for people with a physical disability by TasTAFE students in consultation with people with a lived experience.

INTRODUCTION

These accessible touring options for the Clarence City Council area are suitable for people with a physical disability, wheelchair users, their friends, family, and carers.

The brochure was created by TasTAFE student Rowena Nagy, as part of her major project for the Advanced Diploma of Travel and Tourism Management and was assisted by her classmates Hashini Ranaweera and Vy Dinh, and Teacher Angela Bain.

We also consulted people with a lived experience when collating the information and doing inspections.

Each place was visited by us to ensure accessibility for a wheelchair user traveling on their own and that they are able to access each area appropriately and easily.

The criteria for inspection was designated as "Disabled Parking", "accessibility throughout for a wheelchair user" and "Disabled Toilet".

We wanted to ensure that when travelling, everyone has a choice about where they can go.

This brochure was made with the support of Destination Southern Tasmania and the Clarence City Council, as well as other stakeholders listed near the end of the brochure.

KANGAROO BAY APARTMENTS

These apartments offers accessible unit on their first floor, accessible via a lift through their carpark, and includes an accessible parking space for this resident. The car park space is quite small so you may choose to park on the street. This unit has an accessible bathroom fitted with a walk-in shower and handrails, spacious living room and dining room, bedroom has an easy to access bed, and the balcony also has a small ramp on the outside for easy access.

SHORELINE HOTEL ACCOMMODATION

Shoreline Hotel Accommodation in Mornington offers accommodation for all travellers across 13 rooms, each of which feature views of Mount Wellington and the Derwent River.

They have one accessible room, which includes an accessible entryway with a small ramp leading up to the door, an accessible bathroom with a walk-in shower and handrails next to the toilet, lower beds which can be made to be one if needed and lower in room amenities which can fit a wheelchair underneath. The entrance to the accommodation is at the rear of the building.

Their restaurant areas are also accessible for those who would like to dine on site. Access to the restaurants involve using the outside walkways from the back to the front of the property. A ramp leading up to the main entrance on the right-hand side of the carpark, with two accessible parking spaces located at the bottom of the ramp. An accessible toilet near the restaurants is also available.

TRAVELODGE HOTEL HOBART AIRPORT

Travelodge Hotel Hobart Airport, is just 3 minutes from Hobart International Airport and 15 minutes from the Hobart CBD, and offers affordable accommodation to all travellers whether they are staying for a long time or a short time in Tasmania's southern region.

Travelodge Hotel Hobart Airport offers 5 disabled parking spaces, located directly opposite their front door. There are 10 accessible rooms - standard and executive all of which are accessible via their elevator and spacious hallways.

Each accessible room features a walk-in shower, handrails in the bathroom, lower beds, and lower in room amenities.

CLUB WYNDHAM SEVEN MILE BEACH

Club Wyndham Seven Mile Beach, just 3-kilometers from the Hobart International Airport, and is surrounded by stunning natural scenery, this eco-friendly resort puts you in relaxation mode with a heated outdoor pool, spa, tennis court, and plenty of kid-friendly amenities.

This property has 3 accessible rooms, each featuring accessible bathrooms with walk-in showers and handrails, spacious bedroom and living area, and a parking space for each unit.

Onsite they have, sports amenities, pools, a spa, sauna, gym, recreational room, and two small enclosed farms featuring cows, goats, and chickens.

The road surrounding the property is all paved for guests' convenience. Their main reception area also has one disabled parking space, an accessible entry way, and reception area. And make sure you look out for the peacock!

BIG4 HOBART AIRPORT TOURIST PARK

Big4 Hobart Airport Tourist Park offers accommodation in their self-contained cabins, as well as offering space for ensuite camper-van and caravan sites.

They have two accessible needs cabins, which are accessible via their paved driveway throughout their site and each cabin has a parking space right outside for easy access. The accessible cabins feature a ramp in front of the main entrance, accessible bathrooms-including walk-in showers and handrails next to the toilet, low beds for easy access, and a spacious living and kitchen area with lower amenities for easy access.

There are also communal BBQ areas if visitors would like to use them, as well as accessible toilets in the common areas as well. Their reception area also has a ramp leading up the main entrance.

PARKS AND WALKS

SIMMONS PARK, LINDISFARNE

This spacious gated park on Lindisfarne's waterfront is the home to a welcoming playground and walkway that is suited to people of all abilities.

The playground has a range of play equipment for those who have mobility issues and wheelchair users. There are four types of swings available- one wheelchair access swing and two high-back swings on chains and one mesh basket swing for those who are able to leave their wheelchair.

Hard paved paths surround the park for those who would like to enjoy the surrounding scenery and waterfront.

Accessible toilets are available and a dedicated public facility 24 hours a day with use of an MLAK key.



This 2.7 kilometre circuit in Lindisfarne's Natone Hill Bush Reserve is suitable for most mobility types and does include some minor hilly areas. Please note the path around the circuit is not paved but does have a clearly marked, moderately compacted gravel path. There is also a gate at the beginning of the path

ATTRACTIONS

THE ROSNY FARM ARTS CENTRE

The Arts Centre is a unique historical and cultural centre of the City of Clarence and was established in 1818.

This location boasts several sandstone buildings, including The Barn which was redeveloped in 2006 and is now able to host recitals, concerts, exhibitions, events, and workshops inside.

The Schoolhouse Gallery has its own claim to fame as being the only public gallery on the Eastern Shore and is home to exhibitions of contemporary art, community art, and historical displays. It has an accessible ramp leading to the entrance and is accessible throughout the building.













Map of Clarence City Council
